AUSTRALIAN CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE NEGOTIATES ENTRY PATHWAY WITH CHARLES DARWIN UNIVERSITY

The Australian Chiropractic College (ACC) has negotiated an entry pathway to its Bachelor of Chiropractic, in conjunction with Charles Darwin University (CDU).

ACC President and CEO Dr Patrick Sim said the ‘Diploma of Health Science’ is being offered by Charles Darwin University, in conjunction with the Australian Chiropractic College.

“This Diploma of Health Science course presents both a stand-alone qualification and a course pathway for students wishing to transition into chiropractic studies,” he said.

“The selection of units identified for the Diploma provide an excellent foundation for understanding how the Australian health care system works and knowledge of current health priority areas and trends.

“The units selected for the chiropractic stream provide a foundational knowledge of the sciences from which chiropractic practice is built on,” said Dr Sim.

CDU Associate Professor Sufyan Akram has joined ACC’s Academic Board.

The Diploma of Health Science is offered both internally at CDU, Casuarina Campus, Darwin, or fully online, allowing students flexibility in their studies.

Students enrolled have full access to all CDU students’ services and resources as well as being supported by staff from the Australian Chiropractic College.
